By the third section of "An Act in addition to the several Acts concerning the Militia," passed March 24, 1840, the Assessors are required annually to "make out a list or roll of all the names of persons liable to be enrolled in the Militia," [vide § 1, chap. 12, R. S., § 1 and 2 of the said Act of 1840, and § 7, of the Act of March 17, 1841.] and place the same "in the hands of the clerk of every city and town in the Commonwealth," in the month of May; and it is made "the duty of every such Clerk," [vide § 3 and 4 of the Act of 1840,] "to record such roll or list of names in the book of record of every such city or town within the Commonwealth," and in the month of May or June, to transmit to the Adjutant General, annual returns of the Militia thus enrolled.

By the tenth section of the aforesaid Act of 1840, the Assessors, or any city or town Clerk, who shall neglect or refuse, at any time, to make the above-named returns, "shall forfeit and pay not more than five hundred nor less than twenty dollars for each and every offence."
