

CHANGES AT TEWKSBURY ALMSHOUSE.

At a meeting of the State board of health lunacy and charity, at Boston on Wednesday forenoon, Charles S. Donnelly and Hon. Charles P. Carter retired as members of the board. Dr. Lathrop's resignation as physician at Tewksbury almshouse was read and accepted. Dr. Wm. A. Gordon was elected superintendent and resident physician at the almshouse. Dr. Gordon is about 35 years of age and has been assistant superintendent of the Danvers asylum the past few years.

According to the *Globe*, at a meeting of the committee on public charitable institutions Thursday the fact came out that the Tewksbury hearing is liable to come to an end soon, as Thomas J. Marsh, Jr., has stated that as the State board of health, lunacy and charity has discharged him summarily, it is useless for him to continue the fight longer, and if the Republicans wish to keep it up they must furnish the funds. It was also stated that contributions to continue would be made by leading Republicans.

The Tewksbury appropriation bill, which was lost from the Governor's office Monday, has not yet been found.
