

# Nurses' Classes at Tewksbury Hospital

Course for Women

Attendants Opens April 1

**STATE HOUSE**, Boston, Jan. 17—A call for Massachusetts women over 17 to enter a 15-month course in attendant nursing at the Tewksbury State hospital and infirmary where such students will be paid \$55 a month in addition to free room and board was yesterday issued by State Public Welfare Commissioner Patrick A. Tompkins.

Graduates of the course, which will start April 1, will be eligible for examination as licensed attendant in Massachusetts.

Applicants must be at least 17 years and 10 months of age and must be grammar school or junior high school graduates.

Another class to start September 1 was announced.

Students will receive instruction in the care of mothers, newborn and older children, medical, surgical and mental nursing, menu planning and home management.

Applications must be made to Mrs. Ann C. O'Rourke, superintendent of nurses, Tewksbury State hospital and infirmary.
