

Tewksbury, July 15, 1865.

At a legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Tewksbury, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, held in the Town Hall, on Monday, the third day of April, A. D. 1865,

"Voted, That the Collector be authorized to make a discount to all Tax-payers on all their Taxes, excepting Highway Deficiencies and School District Taxes, of FOUR PER CENT. on all Taxes paid on or before the *first Monday in September next*. Also, a discount of TWO PER CENT. on all Taxes, except those before named, if paid on or before the *first Monday in December next*. Also, all Taxes remaining unpaid after the *first Monday in January next* shall be collected by due course of law, and the Collector be required to collect the same."
